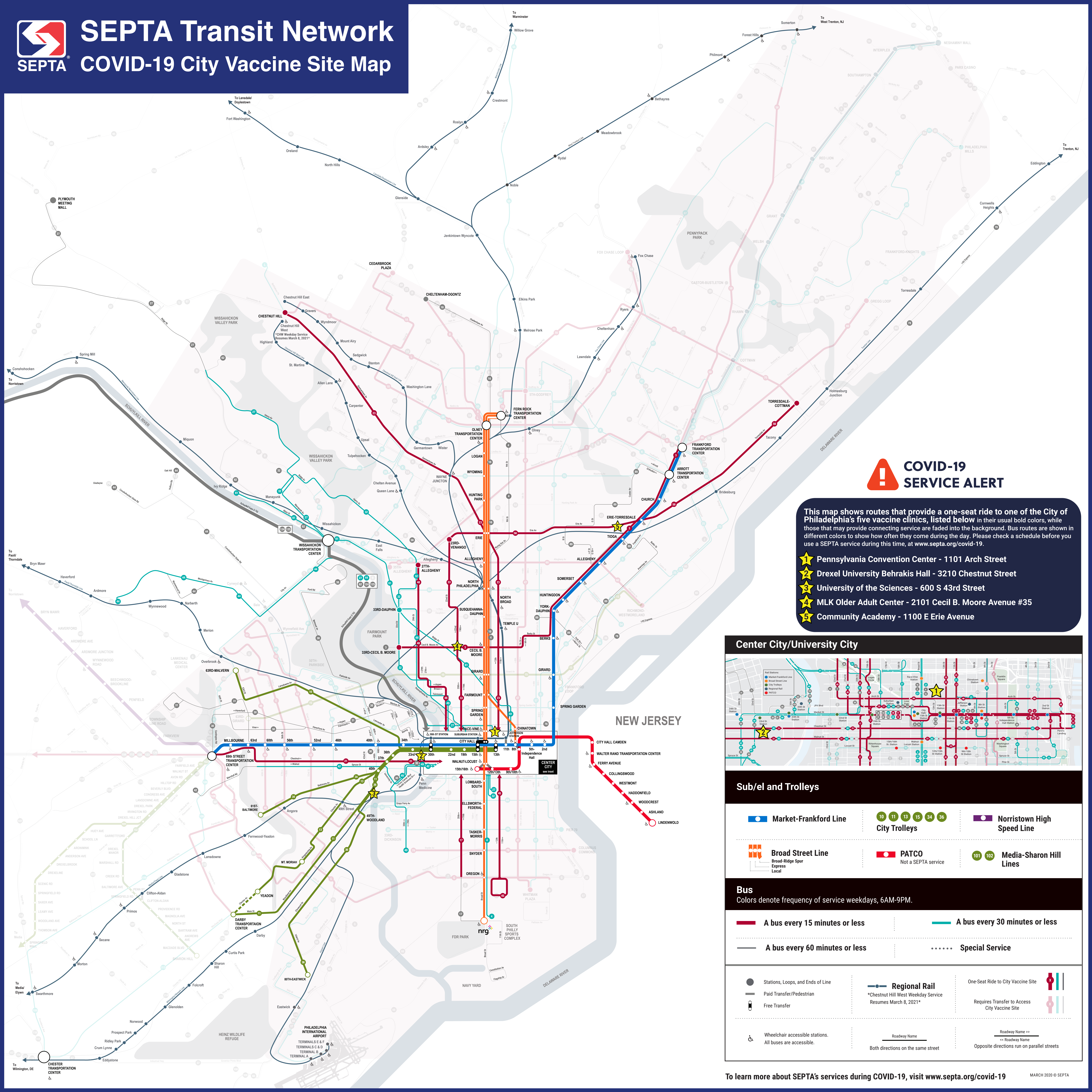


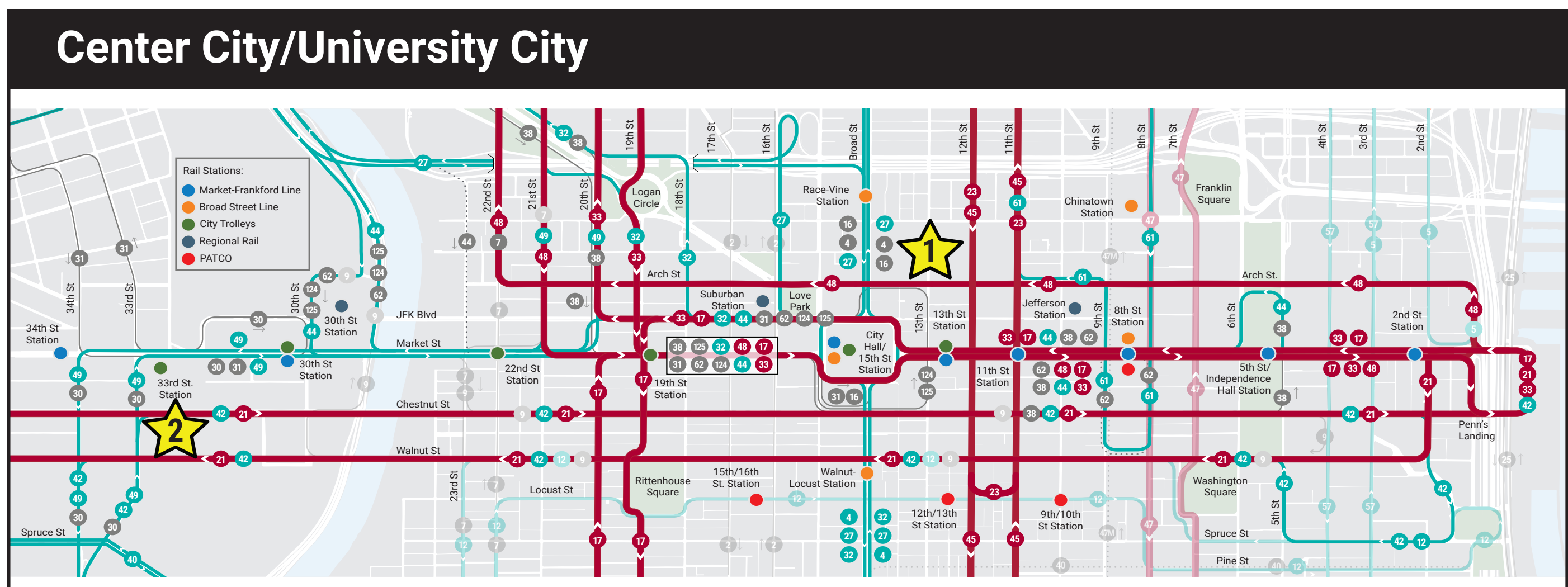
SEPTA Transit Network COVID-19 City Vaccine Site Map

This map shows routes that provide a one-seat ride to one of the City of Philadelphia's five vaccine clinics, listed below in their usual bold colors, while those that may provide connecting service are faded into the background.
