

Exton Station Improvement Project

PROJECT SUMMARY

SEPTA, Amtrak, and PennDOT are partnering to complete station and ADA improvements at Exton Station. The project work includes:

- Expand station parking capacity
- Construct high-level, accessible boarding platforms
- Construct new station building on the inbound platform
- Install new platform canopies, open air waiting shelters, ramps, and stairs
- Upgrade signage, lighting, and landscaping
- Improve station storm water management systems

The improvement work will be completed in 6 construction phases over a 3 year time frame

PHASE 4 WORK

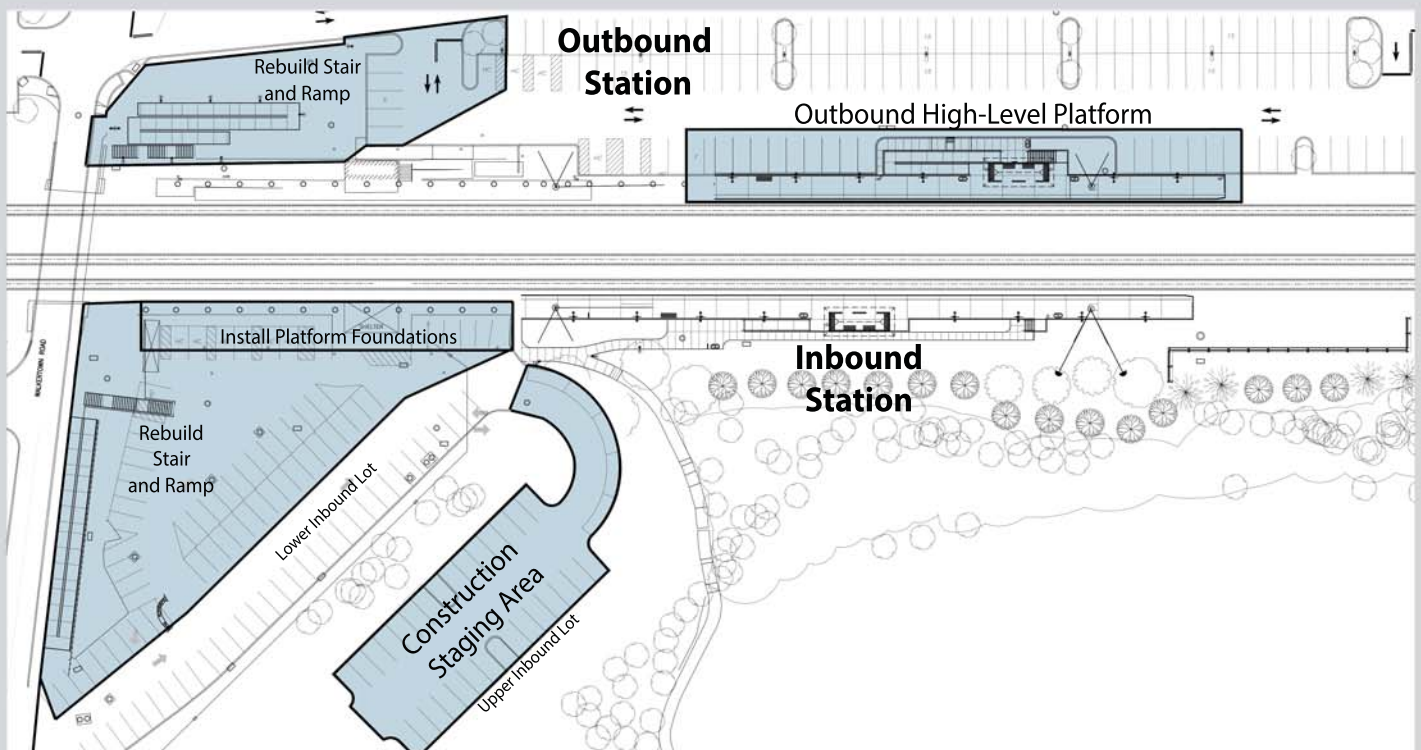
- Half of the Outbound high-level platform will be constructed and will include a passenger waiting shelter, upgraded lighting, site accessories and signage.
- The stairs and ramps to Walkertown Road will remain under construction.
- Platform foundations will be installed on the inbound side of the station.

PHASE 4 OVERVIEW

Preparation for phase 4 of the project is scheduled to begin on **August 21st, 2017** with construction to begin on or about **September 23rd, 2017** and is expected to last approximately 6 months. **While this work takes place, the inbound parking lots will remain closed. The permit and accessible spaces will remain on the outbound side of the station.**

During Phase 4, Customers may use the newly expanded outbound parking lot, which offers 67 new spaces

In addition, SEPTA has added 36 parking spaces at Whitford Station, located at 407 Spackmans Lane, West Chester, PA 19380 to accommodate Exton Station riders
