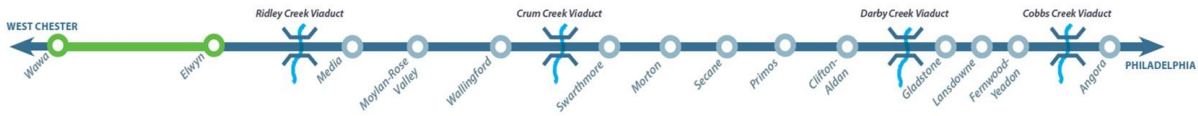


# ELWYN TO WAWA

### PROJECT UPDATE

#### **ROUTE 1 UPDATE: Weekend Bridge Removal Postponed to January**

As a result of remaining work third-party utilities must complete before the rail bridge over Route 1 can be removed, the weekend closure of Route 1 – that had tentatively been scheduled for December – has been postponed until sometime in January.

An exact date for this work has not been set – full details, including detours, will be provided at least two weeks in advance.

As a reminder, in order for crews to safely complete this work, Northbound and Southbound Route 1 will be closed at the bridge for one full weekend (Friday night through Sunday night). Following the removal of the bridge, and continuing for 8-12 months – Northbound and Southbound Route 1 will be reduced to one lane for approximately 1,200 feet at the underpass.

#### **December Look Ahead**

Through the end of the year, the primary work area will continue to be concentrated in the Chester Creek oxbow area related to the removal and replacement of the rail bridges over the creek. Residents may also see ongoing site work along the track area between Lungren Road and Route 352 (Work Area #2). Eventually this work will include the installation of access roads at various locations and tree and shrub removal, chipping (clearing & grubbing) activities, and installation of erosion and sediment controls, both on SEPTA's right-of-way and on several private properties for which easements have been obtained.

**Wednesday, December 12 from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM** – Glen Riddle Road will be reduced to one lane in the area near Martins Lane and the entrance to the Residence at Glen Riddle for work related to this project. Flagging crews will be on location to allow traffic in both directions.
